LO Core Course



The LO - Core Course - is subdivided into six levels and makes English unforgettable through multiple exposures to language, numerous opportunities to practice it, and an intensive recycling of the vocabulary.

It prepares students to communicate in English with a diverse array of speakers from around the world, who have a wide range of native and non-native accents.

An emphasis on cultural fluency enables students to navigate the social, travel, and business situations that they will encounter in their everyday lives.

Entrance Requirements:

- Students must be at least 18 years of age;
- Complete written and oral placement tests to determine their English proficiency prior to admission.

Upon completion, students should be able to understand and use familiar vocabulary, expressions and basic grammar structures as well as interact in a simple way provided the other person talks slowly and clearly and is prepared to help.

Levels

02. ● ○ ○ ○ ○ ○

Upon completion, students should be able to understand sentences and frequently used expressions that are related to areas of most immediate relevance.

Students will master the main points of clear standard input on familiar matters regularly encountered in work, school, leisure, etc.

03. ○ ○ ● ○ ○ ○

Upon completion, students should be able to understand and produce simple connected speech and text on topics which are familiar or of personal interest.

Students will also be able to describe experiences, and briefly give their reasons and explanations for personal opinions and plans.

04 ○ ○ ○ ● ○ ○

Upon completion, students should be able to communicate and exchange information on familiar topics of the student's interest beyond immediate needs. They will understand more familiar situations that are likely to arise when requested to use the target language.

05 ○ ○ ○ ○ ● ○

Upon completion, students should be able to understand the main ideas of complex text on both concrete and abstract topics. They should be able to understand and use the target language more accurately and fluently.

Upon completion, students should be able to understand a wide range of demanding communication situations in social, academic and professional settings and produce clear, well-structured, detailed speech and text on complex subjects, showing controlled use of organizational patterns, connectors and cohesive devices.



LO Business English

The Business English course has been set up to be taken by the students who have already completed level 6 of the IEP or have an Advanced level of English. It is designed for students to adapt linguistically to a fast-changing business world and help them navigate it with linguistic confidence. The course uses the methodology of the communicative approach with the consistent adoption of task-based learning. Hands-on and interactive activities using English in business contexts will promote fluency, understanding, range of language, and ability to express ideas. Classes may complete a long-term entrepreneurial project if it fits the needs and interests of the class.

Students will:

- Be able to apply speaking skills with clear, fluent, organized, and informed presentations, speech, and conversations with a varied, complex, and accurate range of language about a variety of business topics.
- Be able to comprehend and spontaneously respond to questions about studied business topics in a clear, appropriate, and complete way.
- Have knowledge of business terminology and concepts, as well as the ability to apply them effectively and logically to enhance personal and professional communication.
- Construct organized, supported, and informed writing with a varied and complex range

Steps of Enrollment

Our enrollment process starts by creating the student portal access and paying the registration after deciding which course the student will take. The students will have to take a written test followed by our head teacher's oral assessment. Once both tests are taken the level and class will be assigned. Students will be consulted which day and time fits them better. If the class is available on their preferred days and time they will be placed on that class. Given the chance that we do not have the class on their preference, we will inform the student of the options that we currently have available.

Our ESL course takes 6 levels to be completed. Each level lasts 4 terms, which is an equivalent of 32 weeks of Study. Classes are given twice a week with a duration of 1 hour and 30 minutes. On our live online course just core class is given, that helps you focus and learn English to a full extent.

Streaming

All students must have access to a device, such as a desktop computer, laptop, iPad, tablet, or phone.. The device must have working speakers, microphone, and camera to be able to attend class properly. In addition to the device, they must have a good internet connection to be able to attend class without connection problems.

Zoom will be the streaming app students must have installed on their device and create an account to enter class.

After registration, students receive access to the InSeconds student portal, where they can find their schedules and class links.

Material

All students receive an email that introduces them to our online books on the website. In that email they will find step by step on how to create their access, their assigned book license, and how to activate that license. In case they have any questions or cannot activate their license we will guide them through to make their book work.

Every license assigned is updated every **4** terms which is **32** weeks of study. After those **32** weeks they will be assigned a new license for the book they will be using on the new level.

As well students are also able to check all material, notes, and videos, teachers upload on their student portal. Attendance is taken on every class and they can find their record on their portal as well.
